# **POWER UNDER CONTROL**

Jesus pronounced a blessing on meek or gentle people, saying, "Blessed are the gentle, for they shall inherit the earth" (Mt. 5:5). Who are the gentle? And, in what manner will they inherit the earth?

The gentle are those who have submitted their will to the Master. In older translations, the word is often translated, *meek*. However, in our day, meek is a word often associated with weakness or timidity. We have heard a timid or shy person described as being meek as a mouse. However, *meek* is actually translated from a word that meant "power under control." It is a word used to describe a formerly wild stallion which has been trained and brought under control.

Who are the meek? Moses was meek. In fact, Scripture describes him as the meekest man in all the earth (Num. 12:3). Yet, he was far from timid. When others had compromised, he stood boldly for God and led the people to repentance.

Jesus was meek and gentle in heart (Mt. 11:29). Do we need to be reminded of how He drove the money changers out the temple with a whip He had fashioned out of cords? (Jn. 2:13-17). The question of His meekness is forever settled in the garden when He prayed, "Father, not My will but Yours be done" (Lk. 22:42). Meekness is power under control.

That the meek shall inherit the earth or the land is an expression of special significance to the Jews who long held to the promise of the land. From the beginning, living in the land of Canaan was contingent upon maintaining covenant relationship with the Lord. When the people were rebellious and disobedient, they were removed from the land—the Northern Kingdom to Assyria and the Southern Kingdom to Babylon. When they repented and surrendered to God's will, the Southern Kingdom was brought back to the land of promise.

One of many passages connecting faithfulness to dwelling in the land of promise is Psalm 37, where David writes, "For evildoers will be cut off, but those who wait for the lord, they will inherit the land. Yet a little while and the wicked



The way to find lasting happiness in this life as well as the life beyond is to meekly submit to the will of God. The God, who made the heavens and the earth, will certainly look with favor upon the meek. Just as He blessed the ancient faithful with security in the Promised Land, so He will bless the meek of our day with the promise of heaven.
