<u>UNFAILING LOVE</u> (2)

Popularized in 1985 by Whitney Houston, "The Greatest Love of All" became one of her greatest hits. Written by Michael Masser and Linda Creed, the intent of the song is noble in many ways. However, learning to love yourself is not "the greatest love of all." Loving yourself is important, just so long as such love doesn't go beyond its proper bounds. But, if all we possess is a love for ourselves, we will never really understand genuine love or be able to truly sing about the greatest love of all. There is no need so pressing or so keenly felt as our need to love and be loved. Unfailing love is what each of desires (Prov. 19:22).

The source of such love is God Himself. "God is love" (1 Jn. 4:8). How great is His love? David's prayer in Psalm 57:10 provides some insight. He prayed, "For great is Your love, reaching to the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the skies." This, in part, explains why David had a song in his heart and praise on his lips. Again, the magnitude of God's love is underscored in Psalm 103:11 as David exclaims, "For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear Him; as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us." As a man after God's heart (Acts 13:22), David knew something about the greatest love of all. He lifts our eyes in heavens' direction, praying, "For great is Your love, higher than the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the skies" (Ps. 108:4).

God's love is truly "the greatest love of all." In many ways, such love is beyond our ability to grasp (Eph. 3:19). But we can know something of His love, having experienced it in the person of Jesus Christ who gave His life to purchase our pardon. "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life" (Jn. 3:16).
