#### TRUE COLORS

Immediately following Peter's good confession, Jesus began plainly telling His disciples that He must suffer and die at the hands of the chief priests, elders, and scribes. Peter took the Lord aside and began rebuking Him saying that this would never happen. The Lord turned His back on Peter and, in the hearing of the rest of the disciples, said, "Get behind Me, Satan; for you are not setting your mind on God's interests, but man's" (Mk. 8:33). Then, summoning the multitude, He went on to explain: "If anyone wishes to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me" (vs. 33).

Taking up the cross requires self-denial. A. T. Robertson describes denying oneself as saying no to oneself and then adds that this is a difficult thing to do. R. C. Foster explains the meaning of self-denial in these words: "Let him disown the things that have self as their aim and end...." Paul describes self-denial in these words: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and delivered Himself up for me" (Gal. 2:20). Focusing on God's interests before our own is required before we can truly take up our cross.

In what have we placed our true interests? Suffering and persecution has a way of pointing these out to us. If we shrink in the face of controversy, ridicule, or persecution; it is likely that our interests in the things of this life are stronger than our interests in the things of God. Jesus said, "And do not fear those who kill the body, but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell" (Mt. 10:28). There are things more important than the preservation of physical life. Precaution and wisdom should be exercised, but not to the extent that we no longer put God's interests first.

God's interests demand that we take up the cross and follow Jesus. If He is truly Lord, then His interests must always come before our own. Even in the face of personal sacrifice, we must be willing to take up the cross. This is how we show our true colors and this is the only way to find true happiness in this life and in the life which is to come.
