"DID GOD KNOW ADAM AND EVE WOULD SIN WHEN HE CREATED THEM?"

The above question touches on the matter of God's foreknowledge. By foreknowledge, we have in mind the quality of the Divine Being which enables Him to know beforehand all things that will ever happen. God is omniscient. "By this we mean God's perfect and eternal knowledge of all things which are objects of knowledge, whether they be actual or possible, past present, or future" (Strong's Systematic Theology 282). If there is any object of knowledge which God does not know, then He would not be omniscient. If He learns anything today that he did not know yesterday, then He was not omniscient yesterday. But God knows everything. Isaiah describes the breadth of God's knowledge, saying that He knows "the end from the beginning and from ancient times things which have not been done" (Is. 46:10). God knew before creating Adam and Eve that they would sin. He knows, even now, the sins you will commit tomorrow because He is omniscient.

Although God knows everything which will happen beforehand, including the sins of Adam and Eve, this does not make Him responsible for their sins. God made us with the capacity to choose between good and evil. Without such capacity, we would be mindless robots, doing good only because of our inability to choose evil. As free moral agents, we serve God from the heart—because we love and respect Him.

People make wrong choices every day. Sometimes wrong choices result in harmful consequences, even to innocent victims. Is God responsible for our sinful behavior? No, we sin when we transgress the laws of God (1 Jn. 3:4). God knows all things—even the thoughts and intentions of the heart (Hb. 4:12-13). He will know all things at the judgment (Rm. 2:16; Jn. 12:48). But, this will not make Him responsible for our wrong choices. By sending His Son, God made pardon and cleansing available to everyone. However, at judgment, "each one of us shall give account of himself to God" (Rm. 14:12).
