LORD OF THE WAY WE DRESS (2)

In last week's article, we mentioned that if Jesus is our Lord, His will must be at the heart of all that we say, all that we do, and even all that we wear! We further emphasized that Jesus has given important principles about Christian adornment. Namely, He has commanded us to dress modestly and discreetly, without placing primary emphasis on externals (1 Tim. 2:9-10; 1 Pet. 3:3-4). Then, in addition to that, He has strongly warned against the sin which occurs when a man lusts after a woman in his heart (Mt. 5:28). Immodesty is the result of emphasizing the outward person without properly considering the inner person of the heart.

Does it really matter how we dress? Yes, it does because what we wear reveals something about what is in our heart. Peter highlighted true spiritual adornment as "the inner person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit" (1 Pet. 3:4). 1 Samuel 16:7 reminds us that the Lord "sees not as man sees, for man looks at the outward appearance but the Lord looks at the heart." One person cannot see what is in another person's heart. Only the Lord can do that. However, what a woman emphasizes in the way she dresses reveals something of what is on her mind.

In the next place, what we wear matters because it says something about us. According to Paul's letter to Timothy, "women making a claim to godliness" will dress modestly" (1 Tim. 2:10). If one claims to be godly, he or she will dress modestly. What we wear says something about us.

In the third place, what we wear matters because of what it accomplishes through us. People need to see our good works (1 Tim. 2:10). And, when they do, we want them to "glorify our Father who is in heaven" (Mt. 5:16). Immodesty, on the other hand, is calling undue attention to oneself. Modesty is about calling attention to the Father in heaven.

In next week's bulletin article, we plan to deal with the question: "How do I decide what to wear?" Please give this matter serious and prayerful thought as these are matters that influence spiritual relationships, including our own.
