## THE CHURCH IS THE KINGDOM

There remains a great deal of confusion about the church in the minds of many. If there is but one body (Eph. 4:4) and the church is that body (Eph. 1:22-23), then why do statistics reveal that there more than 41,000 different religious denominations associated with the name of Christ? Much of the confusion is the result of not knowing what the Bible says about the nature of the church. The New Testament illustrates the nature of the church in the figure of a kingdom.

The church is the kingdom of God. John the Baptist preceded Christ, saying, "the kingdom of God is at hand..." (Mk. 1:15). Jesus said that many who heard Him speak would "not taste death until they [saw] the kingdom of God after it [had] come with power" (Mk. 9:1). Jesus promised power to His apostles "when the Holy Spirit [would] come upon [them] (Acts 1:8). Who can deny that the Holy Spirit came upon them with power on the first Pentecost following the resurrection of Christ? (Acts 2:1-4).

The church is also called the kingdom of heaven. Matthew uses that expression some 31 times in referring to the kingdom of God. The expressions are interchangeable (e.g. Mt. 13:31 cf. Mk. 4:30). It is called the kingdom of heaven because that is where it is headquartered. It is headquartered in heaven where Christ reigns over His kingdom. Therefore, the church is not ruled by the principles and precepts of men. Any religious institution with earthly headquarters cannot be the kingdom of heaven. Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world" (Jn. 18:36).

This introduces a third expression. The church is the kingdom of Christ (Eph. 5:5). It is His kingdom by virtue of the fact that He is its King. The events described in the second chapter of Acts include affirmation that Jesus has been made "both Lord and Christ" (Acts 2:36). Christ is our anointed King. Those who accept Him in obedient faith are rescued "from the domain of darkness and transferred to the kingdom of His beloved Son..." (Col. 1:13).

In our next article, we will take note of the necessary elements of a kingdom and how they apply to Christ's kingdom, the church.
