WRITTEN IN THE STARS

Jeremiah related the message of the Lord to the people of Judah, saying, "Do not learn the way of the nations, and do not be terrified by the signs of the heavens although the nations are terrified by them; for the customs of the peoples are delusion..." (Jer. 10:2). The passage goes on to describe the utter futility of worshiping idols. Sometimes overlooked is the close connection between astrology and idolatry. The New Living Translation renders this verse as follows: "Do not act like the other nations, who try to read their future in the stars. Do not be afraid of their predictions, even though other nations are terrified by them."

Every day millions turn to their horoscope to learn more about their future. For many it is simply a matter of curiosity. For others it is a serious matter—a daily ritual. What is a horoscope? Jack Carter answers, "It is a form of occultism. It is a part of astrology...the purported art of professing to determine the influence of the heavenly bodies on human affairs. The horoscope is a diagram of the heavenly bodies which indicates the relative positions of the sun, moon, stars and planets at a given time" (Rocky Mountain Christian, Feb. 1984). The idea seems to have originated over 4,000 years ago among the Chaldeans who believed the heavenly bodies were actually gods. So, we can see that there is a close connection between astrology and the practice of idolatry.

Why does astrology appeal to so many? It is likely because the Bible does not supply all the information we desire in matters of curiosity. Deuteronomy 29:19 explains that "The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of the law." Many look for hidden information about their future. But, what they find in astrology is little more than superstition and a cunning appeal to idolatry.

God demands whole-hearted religion. His promises provide comfort and direction. "His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence..." (2 Pet. 1:3).

Instead of consulting our horoscope, we should ask, "To what am I turning?" It certainly isn't God. Is there some other power to which we might turn? Is there vital spiritual information found outside the Scriptures? I think not. Pick up your Bible instead and let God lead you to all knowledge that is pertinent to your eternal well-being. Let His words shape your life and destiny. For to Him alone belongs our undivided allegiance.
