FEELING GOOD

The attitude we have toward those around us is often affected by the attitude we have about ourselves. Swedish philosopher and poet, Henri Frederic Amiel, wrote, "We are never more discontented with others than when we are discontented with ourselves." We know from personal experience that we feel better about others when we feel good about ourselves.

There is nothing sinful about feeling good about ourselves, especially in the light of our relationship with Jesus (Ph. 4:13). While self-centeredness must be avoided, there is a great difference between selfishness and self-esteem. In Christ, God expresses His desire that we feel good about ourselves. Keep in mind that Jesus came to provide "the full and abundant life" (Jn. 10:10). God does not rejoice every time we get our feet knocked out from under us. He does not find joy in our sorrow. Quite the opposite is true. God hurts when we hurt. Jesus is a high priest who sympathizes with our weaknesses and has been "tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin" (Hb. 4:15).

The surpassing love of God, as revealed in Scripture, shows us that He has nothing but our best interests in mind. His word is a blueprint for living a joyous life and entertaining a strong hope for the hereafter. The "do's and don'ts" of the Bible are intended to bring happiness, not pain. For the people of old, God clarified His purpose for giving them His law, asking them "to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and love Him, and to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, and to keep the Lord's commandments and His statutes which I am commanding you today for your good?" (Dt. 10:12). Every parent knows the meaning behind the words: "for your good." Be assured that every command of the Lord has been given for our happiness both now and forever.

The instructions of God also provide a sense of security and well-being. Our Father cares enough to set boundaries. When we follow His teaching, good feelings are produced. He created us this way. Many make the mistake of believing that one has to feel good before he can do right. However, joy is often produced in reverse order to human reasoning. When we do right, good feelings follow.

We are created in the image of God. He loves us so much that He gave His only Son that we might live forever in His presence. These are thoughts that stir the spirit and influence the way we feel about others. A sense of God's love produces a reflection in our lives in the way we treat others. This is our calling—our life's vocation as followers of Christ (Jn. 13:34-35).
