WHAT CHILDREN REALLY NEED

A world without respect for legitimate authority is a fearful thing. Yet, more and more, we are introduced to the perverted threat of anarchy. We see it publicly displayed by violent protestors who take to the streets to promote their own agenda. Rather than working through the system, they resort to fear and intimidation. News flash: Even when we do not get our way, the rule of law requires respect and submission to those in positions of authority (Rm. 13:1). The only exception is when submission to earthly authority places us in conflict with the will of God Himself (Acts 4:19-20; 5:29).

Authority is learned early in life. It begins in the relationship forged with parents. A dark pathway to grief is opened up for parents, family, society, and future generations when parents neglect or abdicate their responsibility to teach their children respect for authority. Tragically, a child without proper respect for authority soon finds himself or herself in a constant battle against the world. Overly indulgent parents, who do not teach their children to obey, are making a serious blunder and doing their children a great disservice. Somewhere along the way, a child must face the stark reality that, in this life, we do not always get our way. A temper tantrum is hardly tolerable in a toddler; but it is altogether repulsive in adults.

Respect for and obedience to parents is not only the right thing to do; it is the road that leads to future happiness and well-being (Eph. 6:1-3). Obedience to parents is a key component to being well-pleasing to the Lord (Col. 3:20). One tourist, when asked about his visit to the States, said he was amazed at how well the parents obeyed their children. We see it every day. Devoted parents, running themselves ragged, providing every available advantage and opportunity for their children; but neglecting either their spiritual development or their need to learn respect for authority.

One cannot teach respect for authority without discipline. Solomon observed that "He who neglects discipline despises himself, but he who listens to reproof acquires understanding" (Prov. 15:32). The ongoing blessing of respecting parental authority is highlighted in Proverb 6:20-23 where we read: "My son, observe the commandment of your father And do not forsake the teaching of your mother; Bind them continually on your heart; Tie them around your neck. When you walk about, they will guide you; When you sleep, they will watch over you; And when you awake, they will talk to you. For the commandment is a lamp and the teaching is light; And reproofs for discipline are the way of life" (Proverbs 6:20–23). Give your child what he or she really needs: loving, consistent discipline along with instruction and example in the way of God.
