"DON'T FORGET"

Most of us have little trouble remembering the date of our wedding. If asked, "When did you get married?", we have a ready answer. However, when it comes to keeping a running tab, year by year, of just how long we have been married, things get a little more challenging and may require a little math on our part.

Ready recall requires continual focus. "Use it or lose it" applies to many areas of life including the memory. In 1962, the people of Wilkinsburg, Pennsylvania put together a time capsule detailing the town's history for generations to come. Twenty-five years later, when they wanted to dig it up for a town celebration, no one could remember where it was buried. Most of us can relate to the townsfolk of Wilkinsburg.

When God gave the Israelites the Ten Commandments, He did so on the basis of the fact that He had delivered them out of Egyptian bondage (Ex. 20:2). The falling away of the children of Israel was precipitated by a lapse of memory. According to the 78th Psalm, they forgot all the marvelous works God performed in bringing them out of Egypt and into the Promised Land.

Similarly, we have been delivered from our bondage to sin by the blood of Jesus. In Him, we enjoy all spiritual blessings (Eph. 1:3). But, when we fail to access this information on a regular basis, we soon take His sacrifice for granted and open ourselves up to great spiritual danger. In the first chapter of Peter's second epistle, the inspired apostle discusses the matter of escaping "the corruption that is in the world by lust" (vs. 4). He builds his case that the diligent practice of the Christian graces (vss. 5-7) is the result of remembering Christ's sacrifice. He goes on in verse nine, saying, "For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins."

When we forget about what God has done for us in Christ, rebellion and sin is at the door. How will we know if our memory is slipping? The evidence is in the absence of faith, virtue, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love. Failure to grow in these qualities is proof that our memory has faded and our love is growing cold. Don't allow this to happen in your life! Guard yourself against it by maintaining a close personal relationship with the Lord.
