### **KNOW JESUS**

Nicholas Murray Butler described an expert as someone "who knows more and more about less and less until he knows absolutely everything about nothing." Some have made knowledge their sole pursuit in life. Yet, when it is all said and done, our accumulation of knowledge is infinitesimally small. The more we learn, the more we realize we need to learn.

Although the ultimate source of knowledge is God; it is His knowledge that we most often ignore or neglect. God says, "'My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,' declares the Lord. 'For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts'" (Is. 55:8-9).

Wouldn't it be wonderful to know the wisdom of God? The way for us to know the wisdom of God is through Jesus, His Son. Paul reminds us that it is "by His doing [that we] are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God..." (1 Cor. 1:30). Prior to His birth, Jesus "existed in the form of God" (Jn. 1:1; Ph. 2:6). He "is the image of the invisible God..." and "the exact representation of [God's] nature" (Col. 1:15; Hb. 1:3). Jesus correctly informed Philip, saying, "He who has seen Me has seen the Father" (Jn. 14:9).

Jesus came to earth to provide a living example of what our Father in heaven is like. He shows us that God is a God who cares; that He is approachable; and that each of us may walk with Him, following after His word.

When we stand before the Lord on the Day of Judgment, it will not matter so much about how we did in the attainment of worldly wisdom; but how well we came to know the Savior. By all means, pursue knowledge. Learn as much as possible. But, do not neglect the wisdom that God provides through His word.
