"Pray When You're Tempted!"

Prayer is a vital part of the Christian's struggle against sin. Just prior to His betrayal, when Jesus fervently prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, He told the disciples who had accompanied Him to "pray that [they might] not enter into temptation" (Lk. 22:40). When He returned from praying, Jesus found them asleep and exhorted them again to pray that they might not fall to temptation (Lk. 22:46). Obviously, Jesus considered prayer to be an important tool in overcoming temptation. In fact, when His disciples asked for instruction about prayer, Jesus included these words in what is called *The Model Prayer*: "And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from evil" (Mt. 6:13).

Why is prayer essential to our victory over sin? If God is omniscient (all-knowing), why must we bring our requests before Him in prayer? Doesn't He already know our most pressing needs? What we sometimes forget is that prayer is for our benefit. It is an expression of our reliance on God. We need to be reminded that we are not self-sufficient. We need God in every conceivable way. We cannot live without Him. This may have been what Paul had in mind when he said that "we walk by faith, not be sight..." (2 Cor. 5:7). But, how can ours be a walk of faith unless our faith leads us to a prayerful reliance on the Lord? Keep in mind the words of Solomon, who said, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding" (Prov. 3:5). Indifference toward our need for prayer is a tragic indication of a lack of trust in God.

Prayer is the means by which we plug into the power of God. Paul said that God "is able to do exceedingly abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us..." (Eph. 3:20). Prayer is a great resource from which we can draw strength for living. It is not, as some suppose, a crutch upon which we lean when all other resources have been exhausted. When temptation strikes us to the core, God promises to be our anchor. Scripture says, "No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it" (1 Cor. 10:13). In times of temptation, prayer will not only ensure a way of escape, but more importantly, open our eyes to that way of escape. Someone has said, "A person can't stumble when he's on his knees." Prayer is a tremendous, but often untapped, resource of spiritual strength and power. Use it today.
