A new day is set before us like a fine meal on a banqueting table. We are invited to feast upon its opportunities. We are convinced of His love, knowing that His is a love from which we can never be separated even when assaulted by all the forces of wickedness (Rm. 8:35-39).

So, when we pillow our head tonight, let it be with the sweet assurance that we have served well, brought glory to His name, and have proven to be a blessing to those around us. Sweet dreams.
