Justice and Mercy

Why did the Father send His Son if He knew that His earthly life would end in crucifixion? While we are deeply grateful for the gift of God's dear Son, it is troubling to think of the agony Jesus endured on the cross for us.

Amazingly enough, the Father knew from the beginning that His Son would die for the sins of the world. Then, why did He send Him knowing He would be rejected? The answer is found by observing God's attributes of holiness and justice. Man's dilemma may be summarized as follows: (1) The penalty for sin is death (Rm. 6:23). (2) We are sinners who have fallen short of God's glory (Rm. 3:23). (3) God's holiness demands that sin be punished.

Sounds hopeless doesn't it? On the basis of human resources, this is a dilemma from which there is no escape. But, the good news is that God has provided a means whereby we can avoid paying the penalty for our sins. Jesus paid that penalty for us when He died on the cross. The good news is summed up in these words: "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Rm. 5:8).

If there was any other way to provide atonement for our sins, God's love would have found it. But there was only one way—the sacrificial death of the One who kept all the Law's demands—the innocent and sinless Son of God (Hb. 4:15). The inspired author's conclusion is that "it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins..." (Hb. 10:4). There is only one sin-sacrifice. That sacrifice is Jesus, the Lamb of God (Jn. 1:29). He is "the propitiation for our sins..." (1 Jn. 2:2). Why did the Father send His only begotten Son? Because there was no other way to provide for us a hope of everlasting life. Divine justice and mercy meet at the cross of Jesus. Justice is satisfied and mercy is provided.
