SECOND CHILDHOOD

We have heard of those who, in their golden years, have been described as having entered into their second childhood. In view of some of the marvelous characteristics of children, we should consider entering into our second spiritual childhood as soon as possible.

INNOCENCE. In a world polluted by base conduct, children shine as lights of purity. Likewise, God's children are to be "innocent and blameless", thus proving to be shining examples to the world around them (Philippians 2:15).

FORGIVENESS. Just a few minutes after being wronged, a child is ready to forgive and forget. How unlike their adult counterparts who sometimes harbor grudges long after the offending cause has been forgotten! Jesus teaches us that the measure of our forgiveness from the Lord is directly dependent upon how we have forgiven others (Matthew 6:14-15).

OPTIMISM. I remember listening to a young lad as he described in detail his adventures in baseball. He was so excited as he explained how he almost caught a fly ball. Rather than being upset and frustrated at having missed the catch, he was joyous about how close he had come to making the out! What a difference perspective can make! Who has greater cause for rejoicing than the child of God? Who has greater cause for optimism?

Second childhood? Why not? After all, Jesus says, "unless you are converted and become like children, you shall not enter the kingdom of heaven..." (Matthew 18:3).
