GOD'S CAREFUL SEARCH

SEARCH ME, O GOD, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:

And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Psalm 139:23-24 KJV

In the adjoining psalm, packed with depth and beauty, David marvels at the wisdom and power of God. The psalmist closes the chapter asking the Lord to use His wisdom and power to preserve his soul. In other words, David is asking God to search his heart and remove anything which might do spiritual harm.

We would be wise to follow the example of David and invite the Lord's search of our own hearts. God knows

what is in the heart of man. He affirms His knowledge of the human heart through the prophet Jeremiah, saying, "I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, even to give to each man according to his ways, according to the results of his deeds" (Jer. 17:9-10). While this passage speaks about the searching of God in reference to judgment, David spoke of God's searching in light of self-surrender. In light of eternal judgment, how much better to submit to God's careful search today!

As finite beings, we have difficulty grasping the concept of an all-knowing God. He knows our every thought and action. He is even aware of the intentions which motivate our behavior. The process of allowing God to search our hearts involves the word of God. The Spirit-inspired word penetrates our hearts as we open ourselves up to God's examination in prayerful and fruitful study. In the process, we are transformed into the likeness of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 3:18). The power of God's word in heart-exploration is revealed by the Hebrew author who said: "For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do" (Hebrews 4:12-13).

In as much as it is the word of Christ which will judge us on the last day, wouldn't it be wise to allow that word to penetrate our hearts, searching out those hurtful and harmful things which threaten our souls? Only by allowing God's careful search can we be assured of being on the path to life eternal.
