THE PEACE OF SURRENDER

We like to be in control, unless something goes wrong. Then, of course, we are quick to point a finger in another direction. But, generally speaking, in everything from the thermostat on the wall to the remote control for our television, we like to be the one in the driver's seat – the one behind the wheel – in charge of where we are going and how we are going to get there. But our illusion of control applies only to gizmos and gadgets which are prone to breakdown and fail. Even in our God-given responsibility to practice self-control, we often fall short of God's expectations and find ourselves in need of spiritual repair.

In order to gain the peace God promises, we must abandon the illusion that we are in control. From one day to the next – with each passing hour – we are but a breath away from unexpected events that can change our lives forever. James simply says, "You do not know what your life will be like tomorrow" (Jas. 4:14). He was talking about the brevity of life. We are like an emergent cloud – here today, gone tomorrow.

We cannot know what will be tomorrow. Because our best guesses do not provide a stable foundation upon which to build our future, we must place our trust in God who holds the future in His hands. He is the God who knows "the end from the beginning" (Is. 46:10) – the God who will never leave us or forsake us (Heb. 13:5) – the God who "causes all things to work together for good for those who love [Him], to those who are called according to His purpose" (Rm. 8:28).

Let God have the wheel and enjoy the peace the comes in personal surrender to His will. As much as anything, this is the message of God's word. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart...and he will make your paths straight" (Prov. 3:5). "Be anxious for nothing." Pray about everything. "And the peace of God...will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus" (Ph. 4:6-7). Jesus says, "Do not worry about tomorrow....Each day has enough trouble of its own" (Mt. 6:34). Instead, "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness" and God will take care of everything else you need (Mt. 6:33). Weary and heavy-laden with uncertainties about the future? Come to Jesus and He will give you rest (Mt. 11:28).


