"HAVE YOU LOST YOUR MIND?"

Like a river winding along in its relentless march to the sea, so is the man bent on following the path of least resistance. Though there are many bends and turns along life's journey, a careless traveler may be reassured by the presence of so many headed in the same direction. Little thought is given to destination because it is so much easier simply to go with the flow.

Spiritually speaking, many are surprised to learn that the road most traveled leads to destruction while the road to life is narrow and, by comparison, seldom chosen (Mt. 7:13-14). Following the crowd has never been sound footing for making moral decisions. Moses warned the children of Israel, saying, "You shall not follow the masses in doing evil..." (Ex. 23:2). Majority does not rule. God rules.

Solomon warns us that "There is a way which seems right to a man, but its end is the way of death" (Prov. 14:12). Perhaps, we are best likened to sheep, "continually straying" from the Shepherd (1 Pet. 2:25). Left to our own devices, we are directionless creatures mindlessly following the latest trend without acknowledging that "a man's way is not in himself, nor is it in a man who walks to direct his own steps" (Jer. 10:23). We cannot claim Christ as Lord without also accepting His right to rule. We can't just wet our finger and hold it up in the air to find out which way the wind is blowing before setting the course of our lives. God has spoken through His word and we must carefully follow it as road map to a thrilling but previous unexperienced destination.

It is not easy to go against the current of public opinion. Former associates will be surprised that we no longer participate in the evil deeds which once characterized our lives. They may even speak evil against us (1 Pet. 4:3-4). C.S. Lewis describes what happens when we truly walk the path that leads to life everlasting in these words: "When the whole world is running towards a cliff, he who is running in the opposite direction appears to have lost his mind."
