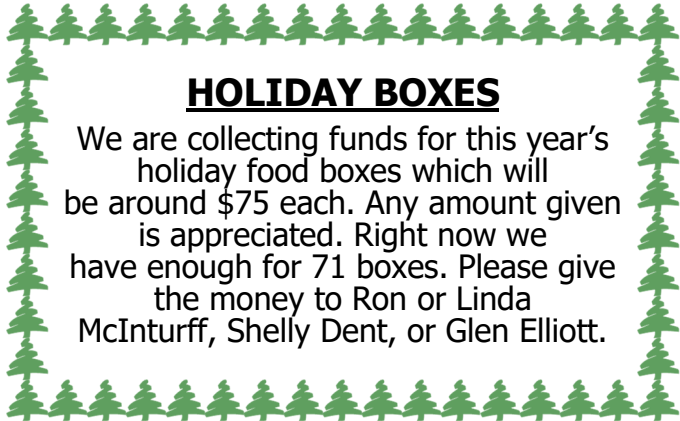
UPCOMING EVENTS
