Make the Most of the Opportunity

While human weakness is largely to blame, many of our unused opportunities are the result of our own complacency toward the lost. First, we must pray for opportunities. God answers prayer. As we use the opportunities God has given, He will provide even greater opportunities (Mt. 25:29).
