## **Great Is His Faithfulness!**

June 16, 2024

Ultimately, our salvation rests upon the faithfulness of God to keep His promises. God's promise of eternal salvation is conditioned upon our faithfulness. We are saved by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8-9). We are not saved by good works; but, neither can we be saved without them (Jas. 2:26). It is not perfection, but faithfulness that God requires of His people. Since faithfulness involves fidelity, loyalty, and devotion to Christ, our lives should be filled with good works that glorify God (Mt. 5:16).

Faithfulness has many benefits in this life as well as in the life which is to come. Faithfulness provides security (Ps. 31:23). Faithfulness results in God's richest blessings (Prov. 28:20). Faithfulness results in increased opportunities to serve in the Lord's kingdom (Mt. 25:23). The "full and abundant" life Jesus gives extends in two directions: faithfulness in this life and glorification in the next (Jn. 10:10).

In a world filled with dishonesty and treachery, there is a crying need for faithfulness. However, faithfulness is a virtue which must be cultivated. David writes, "Trust in the Lord, and do good; dwell in the land and cultivate faithfulness" (Ps. 37:3). The same inspired writer later describes the ancient Israelites as a "stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not prepare its heart, and whose spirit was not faithful to God" (Ps. 78:8). Faithfulness is not an accident; it is the result of careful preparation.

One of the most helpful things we can do to cultivate a faithful heart is to consider the faithfulness of God. In the midst of his lamentations, Jeremiah bursts forth in praise to God, saying, "Great is Your faithfulness!" (Lam. 3:23). These words echo the sentiments of David who prayed, "Your faithfulness reaches to the skies" (Ps. 37:5). In difficult times, there is great comfort in knowing "God is faithful" (1 Cor. 10:13). Peter encourages suffering Christians to "entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right" (1 Pet. 4:19). When we fall short, John reminds us to confess our sins, promising "He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 Jn. 1:9). How can we be disloyal to the One who has been so faithful to us? When all has been said, being faithful and loyal in our relationship to God is but a reflection of our understanding and appreciation for what He has done and is doing on our behalf.
