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THE FOOLISHNESS OF WORRY

David Powell tells the story of a preacher who rushed about one Sunday morning in a frantic effort to keep a preaching appointment. He had to catch a ferryboat and was running late. So, he ran out the front door and jumped into his car only to realize that he had forgotten his car keys. When he finally arrived at the ferryboat, it was a short distance from the shore. Not to be left behind, he ran as fast as he could and jumped onto the boat. "Out of breath?" asked a stranger. "Yes," replied the preacher. "I had to rush to catch this ferry!" "Why," responded the stranger, "This boat is coming into shore, no going out."

This is one of many examples which might be cited to illustrate how our worries often make us look silly with the passing of time when all the information comes into our possession. Future anxieties frequently have no substance in reality. Regardless of what the worry consists of, in the end we look as foolish as the preacher who was rushing to catch the ferry.

Remember that God holds the future in His hand and that Jesus is "the same yesterday, and today and forever" (Hebrews 13:10). If we will focus on God, His kingdom, and His righteousness, our worries and anxieties will no longer occupy an exaggerated place of importance in our lives (Matthew 6:33). Peter exhorts us to cast "all [our] anxiety on Him, because He cares for [us]" (1 Peter 5:7). Spend some time in prayer today and allow the Lord to help you with your burdens.

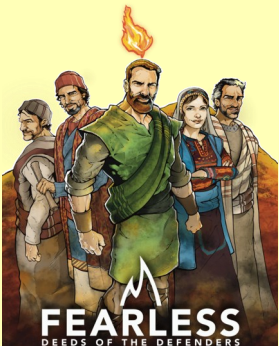
UPCOMING EVENTS:
