ENCOURAGEMENT

We all need encouragement. Encouragement can make the difference between victory and defeat. Those who profess to be God's children ought to be among the most encouraging people of all. Therefore, it should not surprise us to learn that the Bible has much to say on the topic of encouragement.

The book of Hebrews was written to Christians who were experiencing various forms of persecution. They were in dire need of encouragement. In fact, some had already turned their back on Christianity in favor of the less-maligned faith of Judaism. Hebrews was written to exhort Christians to remain true to their calling and hold fast to their belief in Jesus Christ. The inspired author tells them to "encourage one another day after day, as long as it is still called 'Today,' lest any of you be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin" (Heb. 3:13). Ultimately, our encouragement comes from the Lord, but there are many occasions in which God encourages us through other Christians. In the 10th chapter of Hebrews, Christians are exhorted to "consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near" (Heb. 10:24-25).

Encouragement is not that difficult a task. Our failure to do so is most often simply a failure to take the initiative. We want to be encouraging, but we need to be reminded to look beyond ourselves to see the needs of others. As one author aptly stated: "It doesn't take a lot of muscle to give the heart a lift." We can encourage in many ways: a kind word; a smile; a sincere compliment; an expression of concern and understanding; a thoughtful act motivated by love; an invitation to share a meal; taking someone into your confidence or asking them to pray for us; a cheery note sent out of concern; an exemplary life; an optimistic outlook; prayers offered in behalf of the one needing our encouragement; or sharing an encouraging passage from God's word. Use your imagination. There are literally thousands of ways for us to encourage our brothers and sisters in Christ! Don't overlook the little ways to encourage by waiting for "the big way." While the opportunity persists, encourage one another day after day.
