SLIPPING FEET AND TRUSTING FAITH

"If the LORD had not been my help, My soul would soon have dwelt in the abode of silence. If I should say, "My foot has slipped," Your lovingkindness, O LORD, will hold me up. When my anxious thoughts multiply within me, Your consolations delight my soul" (Psalm 94:17-19).

The comfort of God's abiding presence is a frequent theme in the psalms of David. When our lives are crowded with worry -- when it seems like we are slipping helplessly into a chasm of darkness -- God will provide strength to sustain us.

Like David, we should be humbly grateful for the providential working of God in our lives, for those times when He rescues us from temptation or delivers us from trial. Some see God as far away, detached, and disinterested. But the true picture of God, as painted by God Himself in the Bible, reveals a God who wants to be our companion, helper, and friend. As he admonishes us to trust in God rather than money, the writer of Hebrews quotes David, saying, "The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid" (Heb. 13:6).

In the fullest sense, God can be your helper and friend only as you seek to be His. Until such is the desire of both parties, friendship cannot be achieved. God expressed His desire for friendship by sending His only Son to die for us on the cross. How do we express our desire to be His friend? By obeying His teaching. Jesus says, "You are My friends, if you do what I command you" (Jn. 15:14).

Like friendship, grace is conditional. God's grace is available to all men, but enjoyed only by those who place their trust in Him. Paul explains that we are saved by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8). Trusting faith places us in a position where we have access to God's help and provision. The next time you're feeling overwhelmed, remember what God can do. Trust Him. Seek Him as your friend and He will not let you down.
