THEY KNOW HOW TO LOVE

J. J. Turner tells the story of a preacher who was in the habit of standing on the front steps of the church building every Sunday morning greeting church members as they came to worship. He would also give a friendly nod to people passing by on the street. After several weeks of noticing a certain young boy walking by with his Bible under his arm, the preacher finally asked, "Son, where do you go every Sunday morning?" "I am going to the Main Street church," replied the boy. "Son, why do you go way over there? Why don't you worship with us? We would be glad to have you, and it will be closer to your home." "I appreciate that sir," the youngster said, "I catch the bus and go over there because they know how to love a little fellow in that church."

What folks are looking for is a place where people know how to love. There are many factors that contribute to the growth of the church. A harvest of souls will not come about until we have sown the seed of God's word (Lk. 8:11). But, even when we have sown the seed, we are not so naïve as to believe that every heart will receive God's word in the proper manner (Matt. 13:3-9). The seed must not only be planted, it must be watered (1 Cor. 3:6-7). Love opens the door for the gospel. An old adage worth repeating is that "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care."

Caring is expressed in the act of speaking the truth. How we should appreciate friends who care enough to tell it like it is! (Prov. 27:6). Few are as courageous as those who are willing to risk rejection for the well-being of another. However, the manner in which such a message is delivered is of vital importance. Paul told the Ephesians to "speak the truth in love" (Eph. 4:15).

In many ways, love is "better caught than taught." Our example is often the difference between the gospel rejected and the gospel accepted. Evangelism is an every-member responsibility, both in using teachable moments and in reinforcing the message of Christ by living example. In the early days of the church, people were drawn to their message by the love they had for one another. Things have not changed. People still want to find a place where they will be loved. Jesus prayed that we might be one so that the world might believe in Jesus and know the love of the Father in heaven (Jn. 17:21, 23). Our challenge is to so live and so speak that others will see in us a people who know how to love others.
